Shola Adeyemi is the Global Lead of StatsXperts International, a health service research and management consulting company based in Nigeria. He received a first degree in Statistics from the University Of Ibadan, Nigeria and an M.Sc. from the Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife also in Nigeria where he was also a Lecturer in undergraduate mathematics and statistics.

He worked at the Statistical Science Group of the Los Alamos National Laboratory US as a Staff Research Assistant developing novel statistical models for damage detection in civil engineering structures. Shola was a pre-doctoral student at the Katholieke Universiteit, Leuven Belgium, where he worked in psychometrics on a project "Differential Item Functioning (DIF) detection in a Recruitment test", before proceeding to the University of Westminster for his PhD in Health Services and Social Care Modelling.

He completed his PhD theses on the topic "Patient Flow: Random Effects Modelling of Patient Pathways" He is a trained statistician, with the expertise to turn data into meaningful information to help optimize situations in any kind of business.

He consults for pharmaceutical companies providing statistical support into diagnostics and at all levels of drug development, and for Local Councils, PCTs on health service re-design, performance evaluation; among many consulting roles.
